Safer travel on public transport

Everyone is advised to limit their use of public transport.

If you do have to use public transport, remember to keep socially distanced from other travellers wherever possible and wear a compulsory face covering - see [how to wear a face covering](#) for guidance.

You should wash your hands before and after travel or use a hand sanitiser of at least 70% alcohol. Remember not to touch your face throughout your journey.

Face Coverings on Public Transport

The Government currently requires all people using public transport to wear a face covering.

There are exemptions to the face-covering rule, including if you have a physical or mental illness or disability that means you cannot wear one.

Shepherd's Bush Station

Central



Shepherd's Bush station has a large ticket hall. When exiting the underground you have to turn right and right again.



Once you've past the station keep walking straight towards a large green area.

This green area is called Shepherds Bush Green.



As you are walking, Shepherds Bush green will be on your left and there will be shops to your right.



Keep walking straight on until the end of the green area.



Cross the road to Barclays bank.



Walk straight on the same road so that you pass Barclays bank on your left hand side.

You will also pass Woody's Grill and Orchards Estate agents on your left hand side.



Cross the road and the theatre is in front of you.

Bus:



To Shepherd's Bush Market:

Bus options: **207, 260, 283, 607, N207** all stop at Shepherd's Bush Market.

The route from here to the theatre is the same as from Shepherd's Bush Market Underground station above.



To Shepherd's Bush Green:

Bus options: **72, 94, 95, 148, 220, 237, 272, 283** all stop as Shepherds Bush Green

When you get off the bus at Shepherd's Bush Green you will see the Dorset Hotel in front of you.

Turn right and walk towards the junction.



When you get to the end of the road you will see Barclays bank on your left. Follow the road to the left.



Walk straight on the same road so that you pass Barclays bank on your left hand side.

You will also pass Woody's Grill and Orchards Estate agents on your left hand side.



Cross the road and the theatre is in front of you.

At the Theatre:



Entrance

You have arrived at the theatre. You can enter through the front doors. There is also an entrance to the right by the big glass windows.



Step Free Access

If you would like to avoid stairs there is a ramp to access the building step free.



Face coverings

We are currently asking all customers to wear face coverings when inside the building including throughout the performance, unless you are eating and drinking. Rest assured, we are aware that some people cannot wear face coverings for health reasons. If this applies to you, [click here to download a Tfl exemption card](#). This card is not mandatory, but it will make your visit smoother as our teams can easily identify you as exempt.




Registering your details

All visitors will be asked to register their details using the NHS Test and Trace app.

There will be signs explaining the procedure around the building, and the QR code you can scan on your smartphone to make this easier.

Staff will be around to help you do this.



Sanitising stations and Hand Washing

As you move around the building, sanitising stations will be available at key points around.

Please wash your hands when you arrive in the building.



Moving around the space

We have new signage around the building to help maintain a one-way system. This includes arrows on the floor, and signs on the wall.

This will help maintain social distancing in the space.



Bar and Cafe

The theatre has a bar where you can order drinks and snacks.

We have introduced a new way of contact-free ordering via an app that you download on your smartphone. Instructions about how to do this are available on every table. Customers must be seated in the bar and cafe areas to ensure safety and social distancing.



Staff

The staff at the Bush Theatre are there to help you.

All staff working in the front of house area will be wearing face shields. Sometimes they will also have a headset on their ear. This helps them talk to every staff member and manager in the building.



Holloway Theatre

The Holloway Theatre is one of two performance rooms in the building.

You might be asked to come in through the side entrance on Pennard road, rather than through the front door. You will get an email before your event to clarify this.

If you are not sure please ask for help from staff, or email us in advance so we can help.



First Floor Toilets

If you need the toilet take the staircase behind the bar to the first floor. You can also take the lift to the first floor if you would like to avoid stairs.

There are male and female toilets, but we encourage anyone to use the toilet they feel more comfortable with.

The toilet queue will also be limited to two people on the first landing to avoid congestion in this area. There will be a sign that outlines this restriction.

There will also be certain toilets closed to help maintain distance in the room between people.

Please wash your hands for 20 seconds after you have used the facilities.



Step free access toilet

There is a **step free access** toilet on the ground floor.

There are also baby change facilities available here.



If the door is locked, please ask at Box Office to help.



Gianni and Michael Alen-Buckley Script Library

Our building used to be a library and we kept a quiet room full of plays for you to enjoy.

You can take your drinks and snacks here with you.

The tables and chairs have all been rearranged to ensure social distancing. You can order drinks and snacks to your table using the smartphone app. Information about this will be on your table.

All customers must be seated. This is to ensure safety and social distancing.



Terrace

If the weather is nice you can also relax outside in the terrace area.

You can take your drinks and snacks here with you.

If you would like to buy anything else to eat or drink you can do so at the bar.
