Francis Lovehall most recently featured in Steve McQueen's highly acclaimed *Small Axe: Lovers Rock* in his screen debut.

Tyrell Williams | Writer

Tyrell Williams was on the BAFTA Elevate scheme 2018 and was previously a Broadcast Hotshot. He co-created, co-wrote and directed the viral web series #HoodDocumentary which has had over 4 million views on YouTube. Following its online acclaim, #HoodDocumentary went on to be commissioned for pilot episodes by BBC Three which Tyrell directed and co-wrote. Tyrell has original television scripts in development with Fudge Park, SLAM Films and Big Deal Films.

Red Pitch is his first full-length play and in its early iteration won the Young Harts Writing Festival 'Audience Favourite' award when it debuted at The Lyric Hammersmith, he then shared a short version of Red Pitch at Ovalhouse in June 2019.

Daniel Bailey | Director

Daniel Bailey is Associate Artistic Director of the Bush Theatre. He was previously Associate Director at Birmingham Repertory Theatre, originally joining The Rep as part of the Regional Theatre Young Director Scheme where his work included artist development programmes for writers, theatre-makers and directors. He has previously been Resident Director at the National Theatre Studio, Associate Artist at Theatre Royal Stratford East and Resident Assistant Director at The Finborough Theatre. Daniel studied Modern Drama at Brunel University before participating in the Young Vic's Introduction to Directing.
