
Where is the Bush Theatre?



Getting here: London Underground routes



The closest underground station is:
Shepherd's Bush Market
which is on the
Hammersmith & City line
and
Circle line.



You can also travel to
Shepherd's Bush
on the
Central or Overground lines.

This is an 8 minute walk
away.



Getting here: From Shepherd's Bush Market

When you exit the station you will see Shepherd's Bush Market in front of you.

To the left of the market you will see the Bush Theatre.



Turn left and walk to the first traffic light.

Cross the road.



Getting here: From Shepherd's Bush station

Central
Overground



Out of Shepherd's Bush station, turn right and right again.

Keep walking straight towards a large grassy area called Shepherd's Bush Green.



As you are walking, Shepherd's Bush Green will be on your left and you'll walk passed shops and cafes on your right, including Greggs, Starbucks, McDonalds and KFC.



You will cross several small side roads.

Keep walking until you reach the end of the green area.

On your right will be a pub called The Defectors Weld.



Cross the road at the traffic lights towards a pub called The Green.



Turn left and cross the road again at the traffic lights towards the large red brick building on the corner.



Turn right and pass the red brick building on your left.

Keep walking and you will also pass Woody's Grill on your left.



Cross the road and the Bush Theatre is in front of you.

Getting here: Bus routes



From Shepherd's Bush Market:

Bus options: 207, 260, 283, 607, N207. When you get off the bus, walk towards the railway bridge and the market.



Cross the road, passing the market on your right, a Costa Coffee on your left, and continue under the bridge.



Pass Shepherd's Bush Market station on your left, cross the road at the traffic lights and the theatre will be in front of you.



From Shepherd's Bush Green:

Bus options: 72, 94, 95, 148, 220, 237, 272, 283. You will see the Dorset hotel on your left and the green on your right.



Turn right and walk towards the junction, passing the new Hoxton Hotel on your left.

You will see a pub called The Green across the road.



Turn left and pass the red brick building on your left.

Keep walking and you will also pass Woody's Grill on your left.

Entrances

You can enter through the porch at the front of the building, up four steps.

Inside, the bar and Box Office is to the right.



There is also an entrance to the right by the big glass windows.

This is up four steps, via the Terrace seating area.



Step free access

There is a ramp to access the building step free.

The ramp is to the right of the four steps.



There are automatic red doors.

Through these doors to the left is the Box Office and bar, straight on the Holloway Theatre, and to the right the Studio.



Box Office

The box office is at the front of the building, surrounded by floor-to-ceiling glass windows.



Library Bar

There is a long wooden bar where you can order drinks, snacks, coffee and food.

The bar can get busy and loud before a show.



Script Library

Our building used to be a library and we have a room full of plays for you to enjoy. You can read or take drinks and snacks here with you.



Terrace

You can also relax outside in the Terrace area. You can take drinks and snacks you ordered from the bar here with you.



Step free access toilet

There is a step-free access toilet on the ground floor, next to the lift and stairs. If the door is locked, please ask at Box Office for help.



This is a right hand transfer toilet.

There are also baby changing facilities available here.



First floor toilets

If you need the toilet take the staircase or lift behind the bar to the first floor. At the top of the stairs, turn left.



The toilets on the left have 5 cubicles. The toilets on the right have 1 cubicle and 3 urinals.

All our bathrooms are gender neutral.



Holloway Theatre

This is our bigger performance space, seating up to 220. The entrance is through the door off the central foyer.




The layout changes, with seats often on two, three or four sides of the stage.

Seats: 53cm wide, 43cm deep, gap of 7-14cm between each seat. No arm rests.



Studio

The entrance to our smaller performance space is at the back of the Terrace corridor. It seats 60-70 people.



The layout can change, but seats are often arranged on three sides of the stage.

Seats: 45cm wide, 44cm deep, gap of 7cm between each seat. No arm rests.



Staff

Our staff are here to help.

They will wear a green lanyard with the Bush Theatre logo in white on it.



Prayer space

There is a multi-faith prayer room on the second (top) floor, accessible via the stairs or lift. If you would like access to this space, just ask at Box Office.



Attic

The Attic is also on the second (top) floor. It is used for rehearsals, sharings and events. It can seat up to 60 people.



Stairs and lift

To access the first and second floor, the stairs and the lift can be found behind the bar.
